Dear Parents/Carers,

I am pleased to share with you, after half term, we will be able to provide afterschool care between us and the Scott Centre (please find their prospectus attached).

You will need to make your bookings directly with the Scott Centre, who will let us know which pupils are attending each day. Spaces are limited and on a first come, first served basis - there are 15 spaces available per day, due to the capacity of the minibus. Please contact Paige at the Scott Centre directly, to secure your spaces – her email address is scottcentre@youthoptions.org.uk

To support parents/carers with costs, we will care for pupils within school, without charge, until the Scott Centre bus collects at around 4pm. This arrangement will be to see us through this academic year, with the goal to bring this fully in-house by next September.

If you wish for your child to be cared for in school only until 4pm and **not** go on to the Scott Centre, there will be a charge of £4 for this. This will be booked directly with us, via Arbor – details will come out prior to half term.

We are also in the process of mapping out a list of extra-curricular clubs, which will be provided from after half term, running from 3.15 – 4pm. These clubs will accommodate 12 children and will be charged at £1.50 per week, to cover the cost of resources. These will be on a first come, first served basis. You will need to sign up and pay for the half term in advance. Children attending wrap around care will still be eligible to join these clubs, however, would need to pay the nominal resources charge. All details for extra-curricular clubs and trips will come out to you next week.

I hope this is helpful and will ease some of the challenges that you have faced with childcare this half-term.
